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School Demographics

Haleyville Middle School is located in rural Northwest Alabama. The school opened in February 2009. Haleyville Middle School serves approximately 400 students in grades 6-8. The community of Haleyville at large has a total population of 4,173.

Class Setting & Extra-Curriculars

Students at HMS enjoy 21st Century Classrooms, Advanced English and Math courses - including Algebra I, AMSTI Math & Science Labs, band, football, baseball, softball, basketball, cross-country, track, tennis, golf, cheer, and a variety of community service opportunities.

The Process

To begin our CIP Process, various forms of data are analyzed along with surveys completed by all stakeholders to develop a plan that will meet the needs of all our students at HMS. Throughout the school year, HMS collects evidence of the implementation of our CIP. Revisions are made to the plan as needed.

CIP Goals

1. All students at HMS will become proficient in the area of mathematics.

3. Administration will provide support to all new teachers at HMS.
4. All ELL students at HMS will gain proficiency in English as their second language.



CIP Strategies

1. STRIDE Academy will be utilized by all students during their Academic Opportunity class period and in their home setting.
2. Departmental meetings will be held to discuss curriculum alignment, course targets, and progress monitoring of student achievement.
3. AMSTI kits and science journals will be incorporated into our science classes.
4. Faculty mentors will give full support to new faculty members.
5. ELL students will have extra support to make improvements in their understanding of English Language Arts.

Special Services

We have a Problem Solving Team (PST) made up of teachers, counselors, and administrators to assist teachers in developing immediate interventions for those students who may be struggling academically or behaviorally. In the event these accommodations are not effective, we have procedures in place to assess each child's response to intervention and determine the need for further tests. These tests may determine special services needed for a child to be successful. We believe in students operating in an inclusive setting with resource support as needed.

Technology

Haleyville City Schools are very fortunate to have the latest in technology. All of our classrooms are equipped with SMART Board technology, LCD projectors, and ELMOS. HMS has two computer labs and a state of the art library media center. We also have two mobile laptop labs and one mobile iPad cart.
